The Event Bartender plays a key role in delivering elevated, efficient beverage service for weddings, corporate functions, tournaments, and special events at The Rise Resort. This role is responsible for bar set-up, cocktail and beverage execution, guest interaction, and maintaining a clean, organized bar environment—while upholding responsible service standards and a guest-first mindset.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide friendly, professional bar service for private events (cocktail receptions, dinners, banquets, outdoor events).
- Set up and break down portable and/or fixed bar stations: glassware, garnishes, mixes, ice, bar tools, signage, and POS materials (as applicable).
- Prepare and serve classic cocktails, highballs, beer, wine, and non-alcoholic beverages efficiently and consistently.
- Maintain bar cleanliness and organization throughout service (sanitation, restocking, glassware management, waste removal).
- Monitor guest consumption and ensure **responsible liquor service** at all times.
- Communicate proactively with the event lead/banquet captain and kitchen/service team to support event flow and timing.
- Assist with beverage inventory counts, restocking, and end-of-event wrap-up (including securing alcohol and equipment as directed).
- Follow all health, safety, and liquor regulations and internal service standards.
- Support a positive team environment by helping where needed during set-up, service, and tear-down.

- Previous bartending experience (event/banquet bartending is an asset).
- Strong guest service skills; calm, professional communication in busy environments.
- Ability to work quickly and accurately while maintaining quality and presentation.
- Comfortable with physical work: standing for long periods, lifting cases/ice bins, moving bar supplies.
- Flexible availability for evenings, weekends, and holidays based on event schedules.
